What time should I arrive for my service project?

You are invited to arrive at Alliance Church – Appleton 30 minutes before your scheduled volunteer opportunity to enjoy food/snacks and meet your team! If you arrive late, you may be reassigned to a different service opportunity.

Start times:

Friday Evening: 5:00 – Pizza available at 4:30

Saturday Morning: 8:00 – Light breakfast available at 7:30

Saturday Afternoon: 1:00 – Light Refreshments available at 12:30

I live next to my service opportunity, do I have to start at Alliance?

Yes, all of our teams will start together at our Appleton location. This is a crucial piece of serving together for this weekend!

Can I bring my neighbor/child/friend who doesn't attend church to serve with me?

Yes! Everyone is invited to serve during 100x weekend. If spots are available, please register your guest for the appropriate registration using the links below. If there are no spots available for your preferred project, please email GingerLee Hooley.

How should I register if I'm coming with a group?

If you plan to come with a group, we recommend starting at the 100x Weekend landing page, and selecting a service project that can be completed by everyone in your group. Then, use the appropriate registration below to register everyone in your group.

I cannot make it at the start time, can I still serve?

If you are unable to come at your designated start time, don't worry, you can still be part of the 100x Serve Weekend. We invite you to create your own service opportunity, and tell us about it using the 100x Extra Projects Form. If you can, please join us for Sunday services on November 5th to participate in a celebration of all 100x service projects – even those that were completed at another time!

I have to leave early, can I still serve?

There's still a spot for you during 100x weekend! If you need to leave early, we ask that you select a volunteer opportunity with an unlimited number of spots, as indicated on the

registration landing page. You can also create your own service project – see below for more details.

What happens if it rains during my shift?

A team leader will communicate with you ahead of time if your project will be adjusted due to rain.

Can children/students serve without a parent?

Please ensure that participants under 18 are accompanied by a responsible adult.

How does the "Create Your Own Service Project" Option Work?

Some of you already have a service project in mind -you've just been waiting for the right time to get it done. Maybe you help a neighbor with yardwork or provide freezer meals for another family - you can participate in 100x weekend with your very own service project!

There are 2 ways to do this:

Option 1: Create your own project during 100x Service Weekend on November 3rd or 4th

- 1. Think of a service project that you'd like to complete, and consider inviting others to join you!
- 2. Register yourself and your teammates for the 100x Serve Time that works for you using the registration links below. Select the "Create your own service project" selection.
- 3. Arrive at Alliance Appleton for the start-time you selected. At Alliance, you'll get a snack, meet some friends and receive encouragement to complete your project.
- Leave Alliance to complete your project off-site or email 100x ADMIN to see about reserving space onsite.

Option 2: You can't make any of the shifts on November 3rd-4th, so you create your own project another time. You let us know about it so we can still celebrate what God has done through you and your team!

- 1. Think of a service project that you'd like to complete, and consider inviting others to join you!
- 2. Complete the 100x Extra Projects Form to let us know what you plan to do!
- 3. If you can, join us for Sunday services on November 5th for a celebration of the whole weekend, including projects that were completed on another day.
