Position Summary:

The Hortonville Production Lead, under the direction of the Production Director, connects the world with God and one another by recruiting, training, and equipping volunteers to support Worship Arts with technical expertise and production oversite for Sunday morning services at our Hortonville location and designated Alliance Church events.

Worship Art Department Responsibilities:

- Committing to our 23 Staff Culture Fundamentals
- Being an active leader and contributor to our WA Team Nights
- Providing legendary service & hospitality to all the ministries & volunteers we serve.
- Being an active pursuer of God's Word
- Placing individual and group prayer as a high priority.
- Being a team player by being open and flexible to fill non-traditional roles/hours if the need arises.

Individual Responsibilities:

- Developing Leaders
 - Discipling team members and contributors to grow in Jesus.
 - Recruiting, hiring, coaching and developing production staff members and volunteers by monitoring the quality of employees'/volunteers' work, by providing constructive feedback, and by completing annual performance reviews.
 - Maintaining and approving direct report timesheets and expense reports, PTO requests, and other personnel records.
 - Equipping staff members to develop volunteers.
- Innovate Ministry Environments
 - Collaborating with the Worship Director, Appleton Production Manager, and necessary worship leaders and producers, to ensure the artistic vision of each event is ensured, seen through to completion, and remains within the available resources.
 - Galvanizing volunteers and developing systems, under the direction of the Worship Director and through collaboration with Appleton Production Manager, for volunteer care, hospitality, and creativity.
- Enforce Key Systems
 - Overseeing the execution of all production operations throughout all Alliance Church's events in accordance with the vision of event leads.
 - Collaborating with Worship Director in creating annual production calendar (GRID) and oversee its development in collaboration with other departments and event leads.



- Creating annual budgets for all event productions and event production needs; forecasting and tracking all event production and show related expenditures.
- Overseeing and monitoring the progress of each event's production process in concert with Ministry departments.
- Cultivating and promoting a safe working environment with current health and safety regulations and best theater/production practices.
- Managing inventory and overseeing the maintenance and care of all production assets (in relation to Alliance's Events and Hortonville Alliance Services) in a fiscally responsible manner and with optimal cost-savings while complimenting the Appleton Production Manager's inventory/maintenance process.

Worship Team Responsibilities:

- Serve as a contributing team member on our Worship Arts team and the Creative Team.
 - Attend team meetings and all staff meetings weekly
 - Coordinate joint efforts with other specific leadership teams (i.e., Women's, Alliance Groups, Xcel) for specific ministry event focuses.
- Collaborate with Appleton Production Manager to assist with production needs during Tier 1 Sunday morning services (Easter, Christmas, Vision Sundays, Baptism Sundays, etc.)

- Must have an active and growing relationship with Jesus Christ with a passion to see more people around the world connecting with Him and each other.
- 5+ years prior experience in a production manager role or equivalent
- Extensive knowledge in production equipment and technology
- Extensive audio production experience
- Outstanding leadership skills with strong ability to lead multiple teams, delegate and communicate effectively.
- Experience, ability, and commitment to work with and foster a diverse community of individuals and teams.
- Budget creation and management experience required.
- Proven experience in handling production and design processes on large- and small-scale productions.
- Demonstrated creative judgment, excellent problem-solving skills, and attention to detail.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong time management skills with adaptability and the ability to manage numerous concurrent projects.
